Registration Requirements

Parent/Guardian* needs to provide:

1. Proof of Residency

The District requires at least three (3) documents demonstrating proof of residency. The following list of documents are *examples* of documentation accepted by the District. The District will not require disclosure of any of these documents as a condition of enrollment, and all eligible students will be admitted into the District provided that the documentation submitted is sufficient to demonstrate residency.

- Original deed, official lease agreement or signed letter from landlord
- Driver's license
- Automobile registration
- Property tax bills
- Utility bills
- Phone bills
- Bank, mortgage or credit card statements

Please be aware that any determination of the student's eligibility to attend school in this District is subject to more thorough review and subsequent re-evaluation, and that tuition may be assessed in the event that an initially admitted student is found ineligible. If your student is found ineligible, now or later, you will be provided the reasons for our decision and instructions on how to appeal.

2. Proof of Age

- Original or certified copy of birth certificate or
- Original passport

3. Health Record

- Medical examination form is available on-line.
- Please take your child to his/her primary care provider for a physical examination and required immunizations and return the completed form to the school nurse.
- The physical examination must be dated within the past year.

For Kindergarten Entrants:

- Child needs to be five years old on or before October 1st.

For Grade 1

- Child needs to be six years old on or before October 1st.
